

# C. Davis Weyerhaeuser Courtyard, Bellarmine Preparatory School

This project was an outgrowth of the 1993 Master Plan for Bellarmine and represents the continued commitment to the school by the architect. A portion of the courtyard became part of the implementation of the earlier master plan, with the platform, paving areas, lighting, and small portion of lawn. The architect carefully integrated all the edges into the existing fabric of the campus and set the stage for the implementation of the courtyard completion. The completion became reality with a special grant in the name of C. Davis Weyerhaeuser. The courtyard now presents itself as the unifying element in the heart of the campus. It is now the outdoor gathering space for students and the entire Bellarmine community.
