

Denny Hall Roof Restoration, University of Washington-Seattle

Materials and details were used to return the building to its historical roots.

Denny Hall is the oldest building on the University of Washington campus. Merritt Arch worked with the University staff and committees to determine the most appropriate solution for the roof renovation. Merritt recommended that the best alternative was to use materials and details that returned the building to its historical roots. The solution included new black slate (from Vermont), copper flashings and details, a rebuilding of the copper clad cupola, and reinstalling the original historic bell in the cupola. The project was completed in the summer of 2005.
