

Maple Lane School

Merritt was hired to work on several different buildings on the Maple Lane School Campus. In the Recreational Building Merritt renovated the building's power distribution system. Decommissioned transformers located in the Pool/Gym area and classrooms were removed and a new pad-mounted transformer near the electrical room at the Gym was installed. The old gym transformer space was modified to include installation of a new building panel board, replacement of the Pool/Gym area panel boards and upgrading of the lighting in the electrical room and gym area.

Laurel Cottage's main building had a new "storefront" entrance installed and a new 100 square foot secure quiet room was constructed within the existing building footprint. In addition, Laurel, Olympic, Pacific, and Rainier Cottages were installed with new acoustical ceiling and wall features. The project was phased so that only one cottage was empty at a time. All projects were designed using sustainable practices and LEED practices where practicable.
