

Naselle Youth Camp

Merritt completed several projects on the Naselle Youth Camp property. Merritt provided design through close-out services for installing a new classroom building-wide addressable smoke detector system with interface capabilities to the campus building control system. In addition, Merritt replaced the main campus 20 cubic yard trash compactor at a remodeled site located near the new Commissary building. Due to a stream running near the Commissary building that raised State shoreline management issues, the new vehicle washing station, complete with an oil-water separator, was moved to a new location that was not within the shoreline setback requirement. Merritt also managed a study to evaluate settling of a new concrete pad at the new Waste Water Treatment facility. Merritt coordinated the survey subconsultant to test and monitor settling over an extended period. All projects were designed using sustainable practices and LEED practices where practicable.
