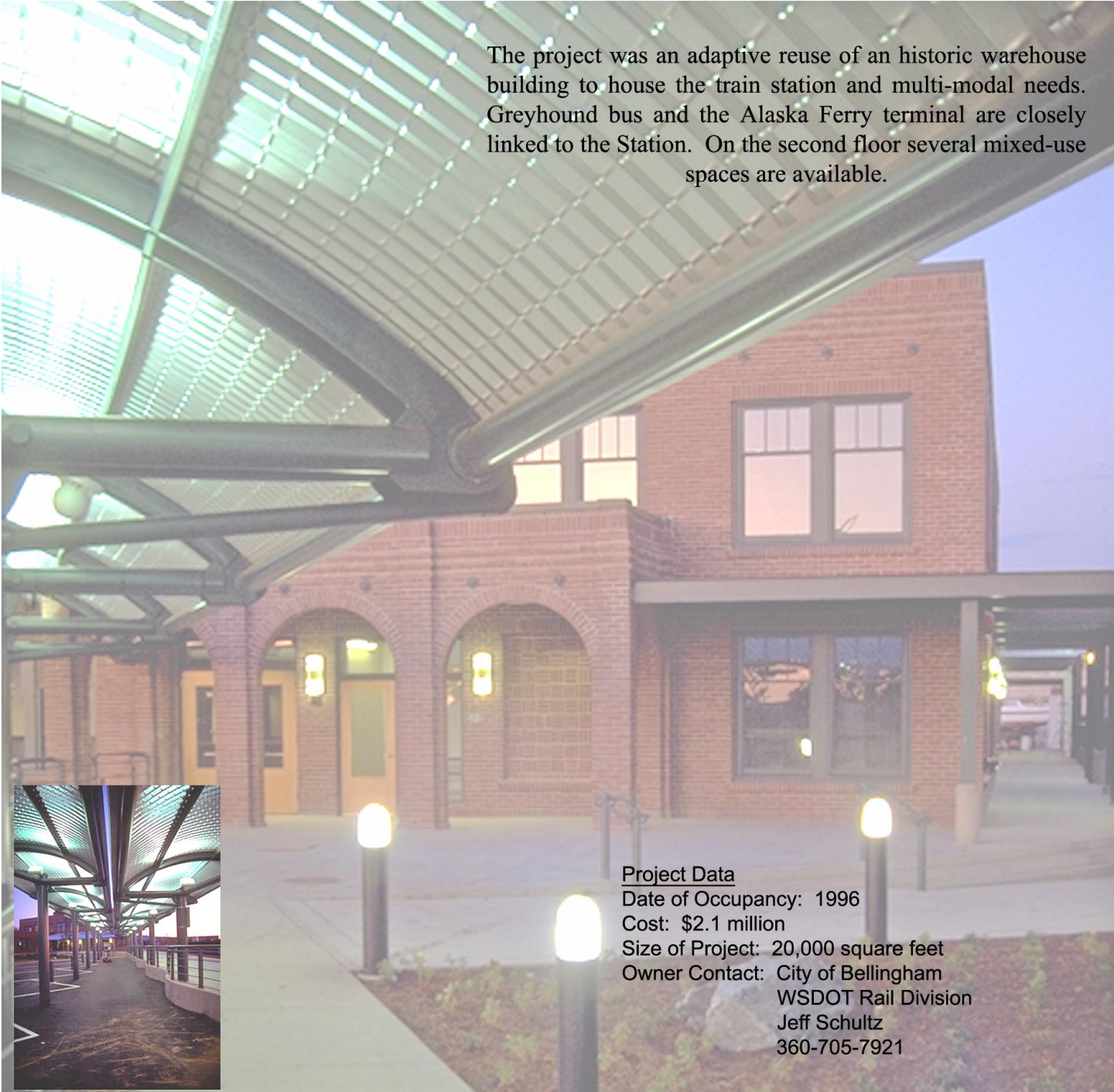


Fairhaven Station
