
McDonald-Smith Building

Tacoma, Washington





The historic McDonald-Smith warehouse, constructed in 1892, was restored and converted into artists' housing, the first of its kind in Tacoma. The facility includes 21 lofts, each with space for working and living, and a common workshop and storage area. Tenants include ceramicists, painters, and graphic artists. Storefront spaces along Pacific Avenue are restored into three mixed-use retail spaces. This building is within the footprint of the University of Washington Tacoma Campus.
