This project was the second piece implemented on the civic center master plan for the City of Fife. The pool is used for education, leisure, competition, and fitness. The facility is used by all ages with activities that are available to all. There are three tanks at the facility: a main 75-yard pool, a toddler wading pool, and a therapy whirlpool. The entrance is linked to the viewing area of the natatorium and there is easy access to the restroom/dressing rooms. The pool is also linked to the open park space to the south of the facility to maximize inside/outside space.
