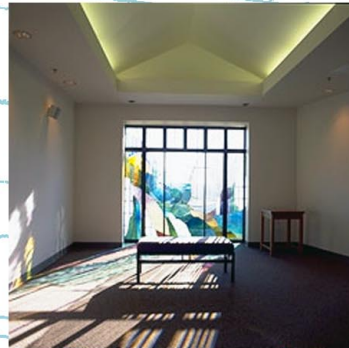


Father Weber Hall, Bellarmine Preparatory School

Tacoma, Washington



The Father Weber Hall Project's primary goal as part of the 1993 master planning process was to anchor the south end of the anticipated courtyard/commons with the religion and community services building. During the course of the design process, and because of budget constraints, the shape of the building was slightly adjusted, but the main programmatic elements were maintained – to provide classrooms and office support spaces for the departments as well as a student gathering area and a faculty lunch and gathering space.

The chapel focuses south over Memorial Field and the east face defines the Millennium Walk to the field. The gathering space and the faculty room command the presence of the courtyard.
